

RESOLUTION NO. 59-1987

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 85-1985, AND
ADOPTING NEW REGULATIONS FOR THE PARKING OF CERTAIN
VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP STREETS AND RIGHT-OF-WAYS.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 85-1985 was adopted on November 18,
1985, and

WHEREAS, The Trustees desire to rescind Resolution No.
85-1985 upon adoption of Resolution No. 59-1987, and

WHEREAS, the Harrison Township Board of Trustees pursuant to
Section 505.17 O.R.C. finds that there is a need to enact
regulations to control parking on public streets and
right-of-ways of Harrison Township:

1. It shall be unlawful for any driver to stop,
stand, or park any vehicle in excess of six
feet-six inches (6'6") in width upon a street or
right of way.
2. It shall be unlawful for any driver to stop, stand
or park any vehicle in excess of twenty (20) feet
in length upon a township street or right-of-way.

WHEREAS, all State Routes and County Roads leading into the
Township shall be posted with traffic control devices
conforming to Section 4511.09 O.R.C., restricting parking on
Township streets and right-of-ways as provided for in this
resolution, and

WHEREAS, the regulations contained herein shall be
applicable to all township streets and right-of-ways within
Harrison Township, and

WHEREAS, whoever violates this resolution is guilty of a
minor misdemeanor (Section 505.17 (D) O.R.C.).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Trustees of Harrison
Township hereby rescind Resolution No. 85-1985, adopted
November 18, 1985, and adopt new parking regulations
restricting the parking of certain vehicles on streets and
right-of-ways within the Township, as provided for above.
