Mike Buchanan, 37 E. Orchard Springs Dr., asked for an update on the drainage problem on his street. Mr. Cyphers spoke with Mr. Buchanan about the drainage issue.

Rose Campbell-Blake, 4310 Saylor Ave., stated she took her grandson to Sinclair Park this weekend, and was disappointed in the appearance. Mr. McClintick and Mr. Cyphers spoke with Ms. Campbell-Blake about the parks.

James Morelock, 2017 Hillsdale Dr., stated he lives next to the Greenleaf Bar on N. Dixie Dr., and he is tired of the nuisance that is occurring at the bar with drunk patrons, people driving through his yard, fights, and trash. Mr. Morelock stated that the bar seems to be open on sporadic days and times. Captain Daugherty spoke with Mr. Morelock regarding the Greenleaf Bar.


Ms. Bradley mentioned panhandlers in the Wagner Ford area as well.

Mr. Jones had nothing to add.




There being no further business, Ms. Bradley a motion to adjourn. Mr. Winburn seconded. Motion carried 3-0.


