**Hearing of the Public:**

Barb Gray, 4624 Cantura Dr. stated she is concerned with 4 different properties in her neighborhood;

308 Shiloh Springs, has a pile of wood from a dead tree along with a huge dead tree that is eventually going to fall.

4651 Cantura Dr., grass is never cut, when JHR cuts it, they leave weeds, and the yard is not manicured. There is also a shed in the side yard that needs to be removed.

4901 Shiloh View, dumpster in the driveway that has been there for months and is filled with shrubs. There is also a window in the back that is open or broken, the house appears to be unoccupied.

3334 Charleston, the property is being used as a multi-family home. The property also has 5 cars parked on the street, often blocking the fire hydrant.

Ms. Gray then stated that she would like to see more of a sheriff office presence in the neighborhood.

Barb Thomas, 3006 Laurel Hill Court stated there is a big hole on the side of Carson Road. House on Anniston may have squatters living in it. Red dump truck with a trailer parked on Philadelphia Dr., feels it is a traffic hazard, also a backhoe parked in the driveway. Ms. Thomas would also like an update on the old Arby's and the Barnsider.

Lajuanna Henderson, 4617 Cantura Dr., stated there are bushes on Shiloh Springs that need to be cut back so that when people are turning onto Shiloh View, they have a clear view.
