Hearing of the Public:

Claudia Bernard, 5070 Aquilla Lane stated she is currently staying with her nephew wile she has work done on her house and she has noticed a neighbor who allows his dogs to bark all day long. Ms. Bernard stated a deputy came out and asked the owner of the dogs to bring them in at 9:00pm and he has been doing that, however they are still barking during the day. Captain Daughtery spoke to Ms. Bernard after the meeting.

Simon Reiter, 5070 Aquilla Lane stated he has lived at this property for 10 years and the barking dogs have been an issue for the entire time. Mr. Reiter stated he believes there are two small dogs and on occasion one larger dog.

Kathy Trimeloni, 137 Bonita Drive stated she is also in attendance to support Simon and Claudia regarding the barking dog.

Garry & Lisa Martin, 4632 Cantura Drive stated they have lived in the neighborhood for 23 years and love it, however there are three unkept properties they would like to discuss. Mrs. Martin stated 4651 Cantura Drive has overgrown ivy and high grass, 4901 Shiloh View Drive has a dumpster in driveway that is loaded with yard debris and the house at 308 Shiloh Springs Road is also unkept with dead trees and high grass. Ms. Crow spoke to the residents.

Barbara Thomas, 3006 Laurel Hill stated she also lives near Mr. and Mrs. Martin and would also like to see something done about the three unkept properties in her neighborhood.

Barbara Gray, 4624 Cantura Drive asked what the Township can do about houses with back taxes and that being unkept. Ms. Crow spoke to Ms. Gray after the meeting.

Dorothy Martin, 66 W. Floyd Ave., stated she has been dealing with an abandon shed on her property that is not owned by her, since prior to the 2019 tornados. Ms. Martin stated her neighbors have brought yard debris over to the shed because they know it is

abandoned. Ms. Martin stated it cost her close to \$10,000 to remove the debris around the shed along with work she had done to her yard due to erosion by a manhole in the neighbor's yard that backs up. Ms. Martin stated she needs the Townships help with these matters. Mr. Cyphers spoke to Ms. Martin regarding the manhole.

Angela Hoskins, 2513 Ontario stated the streetlights in her neighborhood do not work and she pays taxes and would like to see them fixed. Ms. Hoskins would like to request a 4-way stop at Onieda and Bellfontaine. Ms. Hoskins also stated she recently received a violation for her pool that is in her front yard.

Carol Fairchild, 2700 Oneida Ave., stated she is constantly calling the police for cars running stop signs and speeding. Ms. Fairchild would also like to see more of a police presence in the neighborhood.
